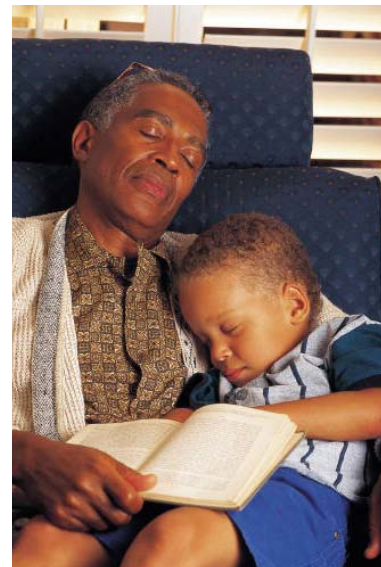
DOES YOUR CHILD STRUGGLE WITH:
