ORDINANCE # 2002-06

**AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY
"GENERAL PARK RULES"**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Beverly has determined that there is a need to provide for the safety of the public, cleanliness of park lands, and integrity of park equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Beverly has determined that the City Ordinances do not currently address these issues adequately, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Beverly has also determined that it is appropriate for these rules to be posted at the entrance to each City park, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Beverly, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that the City Code of the City of Beverly be and is hereby amended by the addition of the following provisions:

SECTION ONE: GENERAL PARK RULES:

1. All parks shall be open from sunrise to sunset.
2. No children over age five shall be permitted on the baby / toddler swings or equipment intended for use by young children.
3. Adult supervision of children under the age of thirteen is required at all times. Children shall not be left unattended in the park.
4. No littering shall be permitted in the park.
5. No bottles, containers or other items made of glass are permitted in the park.
6. No one shall damage, disfigure, or remove park equipment, structures, or natural resources.
7. No loud or disruptive behavior is permitted such as will disturb neighboring residences.
8. No smoking shall be permitted on park grounds.
9. No alcoholic beverages are permitted.
10. All pets must be kept on a leash not more than six feet in length.
11. Pet owners shall clean up pet wastes and remove to a proper receptacle.
12. Playground equipment shall not be used if wet or if equipment or ground cover is frozen.
13. No person shall use the park in violation of posted Park Rules or City Ordinances.

14. Parks are a Drug Free Zone.

SECTION TWO: The foregoing rules shall be prominently posted at each entrance to each City park.

SECTION THREE: Violations of Park Rules shall be punishable by a fine of \$50.00 for the first offense; \$100.00 for the second offense; and not less than \$150.00 nor more than \$500.00 for a third offense. In addition, in the event of damage or loss to equipment or property, the Court may order restitution to be paid.

SECTION FOUR: Council may by Resolution, suspended or alter these rules during temporary special events, emergencies, or other circumstances provided alternate provisions are made for the protection of the public, cleanliness of the park, and integrity of park equipment.

SECTION FIVE: All Ordinances and provisions thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.


SECTION SIX: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.
