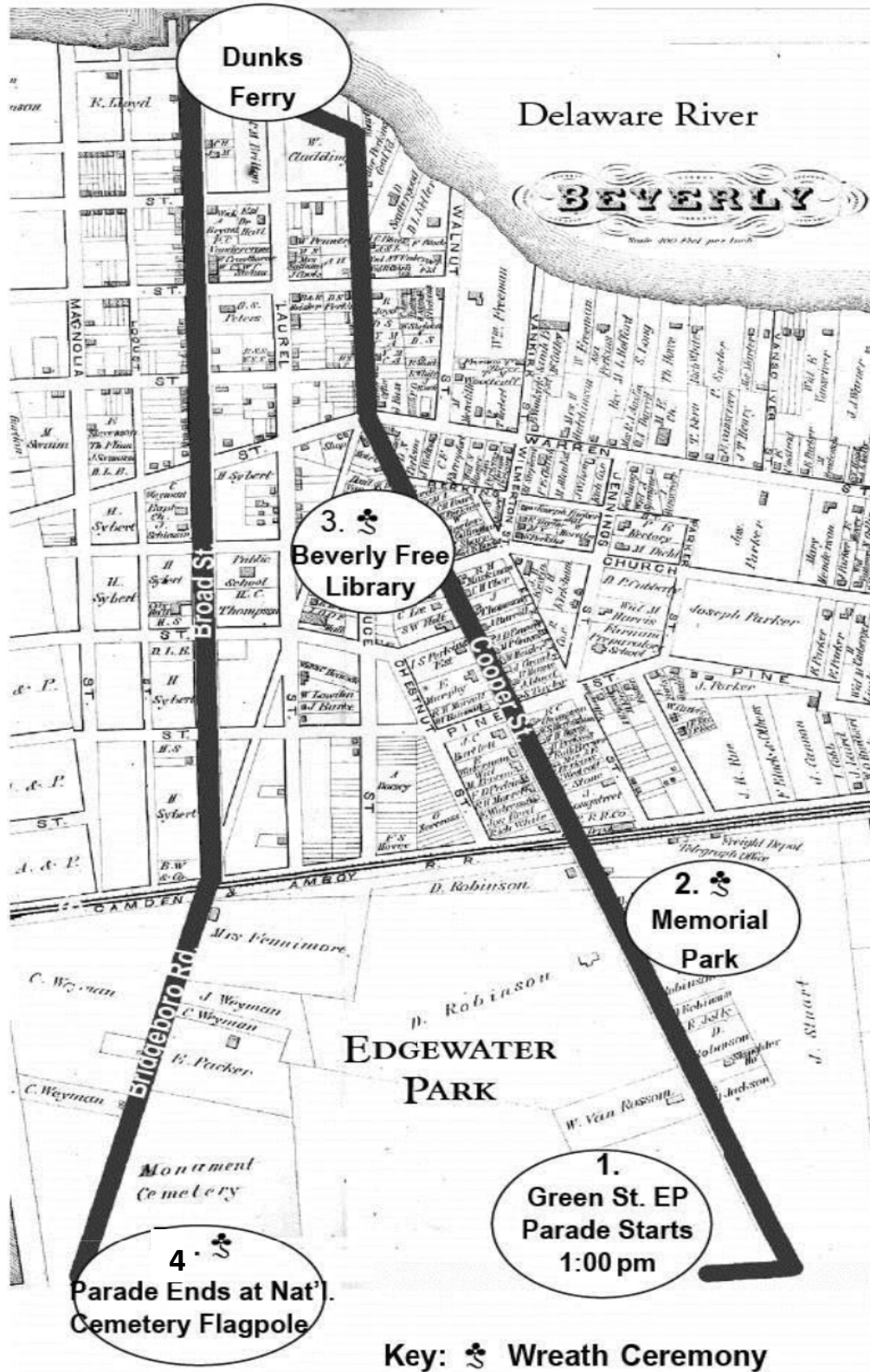

A little-known tradition to the outside civilian world, "the white table" originated during the time of the Vietnam War as a symbol for and remembrance to service members held prisoner of war or missing in action. Solitary and solemn, it is the table where no one will ever sit.

It was just a little white table....

To show one soldier's lonely battle against many.

We cover it with a white cloth to honor a soldier's

Pure heart when he answers his country's call to duty.

We place a lemon slice and grains of salt on a plate.

To show a captive soldier's bitter fate and the tears of families

Waiting for loved ones to return.

We push an empty chair to the table

For the missing soldiers who are not here.

We lay a black napkin for the sorrow of captivity,

And turn over a glass for the meal that won't be eaten.

We place a white candle for peace and finally, a red rose

In a vase tied with a red ribbon for the hope that

All our missing will return someday.

It was just a little white table....

DR. EUGENE J. RICHARDSON, JR

Eugene J. Richardson, Jr. was born on September 18, 1925, in Cleveland, Ohio. He received his early childhood education primarily in Toledo, Ohio.

Dr. Richardson was living in Camden, NJ, when he earned the status of Pre Aviation Cadet in the Army Air Corps and entered active duty in October, 1943, at Kessler Field, Mississippi. In February, 1944, Eugene went to Tuskegee, Alabama for pilot training and subsequently received his pilot's wings and officer's commission on March 11, 1945, in class 45A.

Eugene trained for combat in the P-40 and P-47 aircraft at Walterboro Army Air Field, South Carolina.

The war ended in Europe before Eugene saw combat. He left military service in July 1946 to pursue his goal of higher education. He earned a Bachelor of Science degree from Temple University and a Master and Doctorate in Education from Pennsylvania State University.

Dr. Richardson taught math and science, was a vice principal and principal of various middle schools in the School District of Philadelphia. He retired from education after thirty-five years of service.

Eugene enjoys sharing special times with family, mentoring, and lecturing. He works with his wife in their non-profit called Find Your Wings - a youth career development organization dedicated to perpetuating the legacy of the Tuskegee Airmen through dream, desire and discipline.

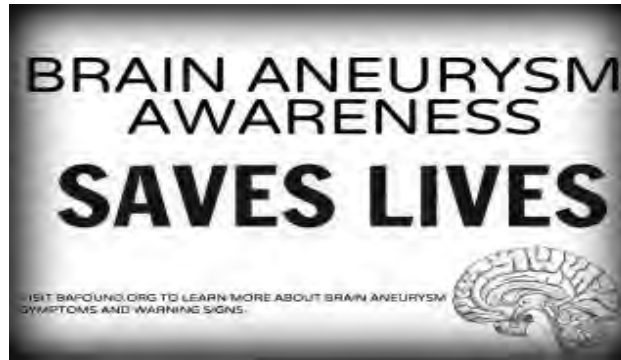

April 2019 marks the 102th anniversary of American involvement in World War. When America entered the war, clubwomen swung into action both at home and overseas. Members of GFWC extended their efforts to supporting American troops by raising almost \$5,000,000 in Liberty Bonds, \$90,000 for the Red Cross, and raised a total of \$183,307 through the War Department. Clubwomen also showed courage on the battle field. GFWC formed its own overseas unit, which sailed to France in early 1919. The 40 woman aided troops throughout France, Belgium, and Germany.
