

2020 GENERAL ELECTION INFORMATION

NOVEMBER 3, 2020

Pursuant to Governor Murphy's Executive Order #177 and #179, the General Election to be held on November 3, 2020 will be conducted **primarily by vote by mail**. Here's some important information to know:

- The deadline to register to vote is October 13, 2020. You may register to vote via paper application, or online at the New Jersey Division of Elections website.
- All active registered voters will **automatically** be mailed a ballot. You do not need to apply for a mail-in ballot unless you are changing your address.
- All ballots will be **mailed on or before October 5th**.
- Voters will not be receiving sample ballots in the mail.
- **ALL IN-PERSON VOTING AT POLLING LOCATIONS WILL BE BY PROVISIONAL BALLOT ONLY.** Accommodations will be made for voters with disabilities.

HOW CAN I RETURN MY MAIL-IN BALLOT?

1. Ballots may be mailed using the postage paid return envelope. The envelope must be postmarked on, or before, November 3rd.
2. Ballots may be deposited in one of the secure ballot boxes located throughout the County. Locations will be posted when available.
3. You may deliver your OWN ballot, sealed in the provided return envelope, to the poll workers at your polling location on Election Day where they will be secured and delivered to the County once the polls have closed.
4. Ballots may be returned to the County Board of Elections by personal delivery or authorized ballot bearer. Identification must be provided when signing the bearer book.

You may track the status of your mail-in ballot by registering online at the New Jersey Division of Election's website.
